This is an application for bail submitted u/s 483 of BNSS on behalf of the accused/petitioner, namely **(1) Maserul Islam and (2) Minarul Islam** in connection with Chanchal P.S. Case No. 124 of 2026 dated 10-02-2026 u/s 85/108/49 of BNS corresponding to G.R. Case No. 412/2026.

In view of the solemn order No. 50/G dated 23.02.2023 passed by the Learned District Judge, Malda regular P.O. is busy in connection of exercise of SIR process.

At the very outset, learned Counsel for the accused/ petitioners submits before this court that no such application u/s 483 of BNSS is either pending and/or disposed of in the negative by the Hon'ble High Court Calcutta.

The case is fixed for hearing of the bail petition of the accused.

Bail petition is moved on behalf of the accused.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that the death of the deceased took place at the parental of the deceased and the allegations if any is not against the petitioner, who are the in-laws of the deceased.

Ld. Counsel for the accused further submitted that the accused persons be in-laws have already undergone substantial detention for which bail may be granted on any terms as deemed fit and proper by the Ld. Court.

Ld. Public Prosecutor-in-charge opposes the prayer for bail.

Heard the both sides.

Perused the case record, CD and other materials on record.

Perusal of the CD reveals that there are materials that are forthcoming against the accused petitioners. The statements of the witnesses as cited in page no. 24, 25, 26 and 27 of the CD discloses incriminating materials against both the accused persons. Further, it would be proper to give some more time to the prosecution agency to augment in the investigation. Thus, in lieu of the above the Court is not inclined to allow the bail prayer of the accused person at this stage more so when the investigation is at a very nascent stage. Thus, the bail prayer stands rejected.

LCR and CD be returned.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
