Accused **Kabijul Mondal, Yogesh Kumar, Narendra Kumar and Sanoj Kumar** are produced through V.C. from correctional home.

Report from I.O has not yet been received.

Learned Advocate on behalf of accused person **Sanoj Kumar** prays for bail on the ground that the accused is detained in custody for long. He is innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. There is no chance of abscondance. He further submits that at the time of arrest, he was not communicated the ground of arrest.

Heard both sides.

Copy served.

Perused the bail petition along with other materials on record.

Learned Special P.P. has raised strong objection.

It appears from the record that this accused was brought on record on 25.11.2024. An inter-state drug paddlers are involved in this case. Some are arrested by STF and from the possession of accused huge quantity of Ascetic Anhydride and other contraband was recovered which is commercial quantity.

It further appears from the materials on record that the accused is a resident of another state, if he is released on bail, there is every chance of abscondance.

Considering the nature of offence, and as the contraband is commercial quantity and in view of the provisions under section 37 of NDPS Act and in view of the serious impact of the offence upon the society, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the accused.

Hence, the bail prayer is considered and **rejected**.
