The accused persons namely **Kabijul Mondal, Yogesh Kumar and Narendra Kumar** are produced before this court after completion 07 days P.C period as per early order dated,24.09.2024. Seen the Forwarding report of I.O, accused challan and medical slip .

They are taken into custody and remanded to J/C.

Learned Advocates on behalf of accused persons **Kabijul Modal, Yogesh Kumar and Narendra Kumar** file separate bail petitions praying for bail on the ground that the accused are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. Recovery has already been made. There is no chance of abscondance.

Heard both sides.

Perused the bail petition along with other materials on record.

Learned Special P.P. has raised strong objection.

It appears from the record that the accused persons are the residents of different states and they are involved in inter State illegal trafficking of drugs. They were apprehended by STF West Bengal and from their possession **101.38 Kg Alprazolam and 210 Kg Acetic Anhydride** were recovered which are commercial quantity. The offence is very serious in nature. If at this stage, the accused be released on bail, there is every chance of absconding. The investigation is going on.

Considering the nature of offence, and in view of the serious impact of the offence upon the society, and in view of provision under section 37 of NDPS Act, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the accused persons .

Hence, the bail prayer is considered and **rejected**.
