The application for anticipatory bail **U/s 482 of the BNSS** filed on behalf of petitioners, namely, **(1) Mangal Sarkar, (2) Parbhathi Sarkar, (3) Alo Sarkar and (4) Priya Sarkar @ Minati Sarkar** who apprehend arrest in connection with **Krishnaganj P.S. Case No.89/2026** dated **04.03.2026** under **sections 329(3)/115(2)/118(2)/324(4)/352/3(5) of the BNS, 2023** is taken up for hearing along with LCR and CD.

Heard Learned Advocate for the petitioners as well as Learned Public Prosecutor.

At the outset, Learned Advocates of both sides state that no similar bail application is preferred, pending before or rejected by any Higher Court of law.

Rummaging the materials so far available, I find that the FIR was registered on 04.03.2026 over the incident happened on 03.03.2026.

Perused the injury report. The victim was treated in the hospital as outdoor patient.

Considered the submissions of both sides.

Perused the materials on record and CD.

Considering the materials available in CD and being conceived by the submissions made by both sides, I am of the view that there is no need for custodial interrogation of the present petitioners, above named, for the purpose of investigation in this case.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail under section 482 of the BNSS stands **allowed**.

Each of the petitioners, above named, are directed to **surrender before the Learned CJM, Nadia within seven days** from this day of passing the order.

In case the **petitioners, above named**, surrender before the concerned Learned Court, each of them may find bail of **Rs.3000/-** with **two sureties** of Rs.1500/- each, subject to the **satisfaction of Learned CJM, Nadia** and on **conditions** as is envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS, with further **direction** upon the **petitioner nos.1, above named**, that he will **meet the investigating officer twice in a week**, till the submission of report by the investigating officer.

CD and LCR be returned.

Criminal Misc. Case, is, thus, finally disposed of.
