Ld. Advocate for the accused **Biswajit Poddar** had filed a petition praying for bail on 16.07.2025 and accordingly, today is fixed for hearing of the said bail application.

Ld. Special P.P. (POCSO) is appeared for the State.

Heard the Ld. Advocate of both sides.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submitted that the accused is in custody since 21.03.2025 and he did not commit any such offence as alleged in the FIR. He further submitted that the evidence of VG and de-facto complainant are examined today and there is no incriminating materials in the evidence against the present accused person. He further submitted that the accused is having permanent residence within the jurisdiction of this Court and there is no chance of absconding the accused and, thus, he prays for bail on any terms and conditions.

On the other hand, Ld. Special PP (POCSO) raised strong objection and left the matter before the Court for discretion.

De-facto complainant is personally present and stated before the Court that he has no objection against the bail application.

Perused the case record and the CD.

On perusal of the evidence of the VG as well as the de-facto complainant of this case, I find that there is no incriminating materials

in the evidence against the present accused person to detain him in custody any further and moreover, the de-facto complainant has no objection if the accused is released on bail.

Considering the evidences so far produced by the prosecution, period of detention of the present accused and oral submission of the de-facto complainant, I am inclined to enlarge the accused on bail.

Accordingly, the accused person namely **Biswajit Poddar** may find an AI bail of Rs. 5,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/-each, till next date subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. CJM, Krishnagar, Nadia i.d. to J/C till date.
