The application for bail **U/s 483 of the BNSS** filed on behalf of petitioner **Shubhankar Ghosh** who is in custody in connection with **Dhubulia P.S. Case No.93/2026** dated **04.03.2026** under **sections 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/64/62/3(5) of the BNS, 2023** is taken up for hearing along with LCR and CD.

Heard Learned Advocate for the petitioner as well as Learned Public Prosecutor.

At the outset, Learned Advocates of both sides state that no similar bail application is preferred, pending before or rejected by any Higher Court of law.

Rummaging the materials so far available, I find that the FIR was registered on 04.03.2026 over the incident happened on 03.03.2026.

It is the contention of the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that there is counter case being Dhubulia PS Case No.91/2026 dated 03.03.2026 and his client is in custody since 07.04.2026.

Objection is raised by the Learned Public Prosecutor-in-Charge against the prayer for bail under section 483 of the BNSS referring the materials available in the CD.

As per contents of the written complaint, there was love relation in between the victim and present petitioner.

Perused the confidential statement given by the victim. The victim refused to be examined by the Doctor.

Considered the submissions of both sides.

Perused the other materials on record and in CD.

Considering the materials available in the CD and considering the period of detention and being conceived by the submissions made by both sides, I am of the view that further detention of the present petitioner is not necessary for the purpose of investigation in this case.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail under section 483 of the BNSS stands **allowed.**

The petitioner, stated above, may find bail of **Rs.10000/-** with two sureties of Rs.5000/- each, one of them must be a **cash surety** by way of fixed deposit certificate, NSC certificate, etc., subject to the satisfaction of **Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nadia at Krishnagar**, with direction upon the petitioner **to meet the investigating officer twice in a week** till submission of the report by the investigation officer.

CD and LCR be returned.

Criminal Misc. Case, is, thus, finally disposed of.
