The application for anticipatory bail **U/s 482 of the BNSS** filed on behalf of petitioners, namely, **(1) Amir Hossen Mondal, (2) Aalamgir Mandal, (3) Saddam Hosen Mandal, (4) Anchhar Ali Mondal, (5) Sahajahan Mondal, (6) Sharif Ali Mandal and (7) Ibrahim Mondal** who apprehend arrest in connection with **Gangnapur P.S. Case No.101/2026** dated **24.04.2026** under **sections 329(3)/115(2)/117(2)/109/74/3(5) of the BNS, 2023** is taken up for hearing along with LCR and CD.

Heard Learned Advocate for the petitioners as well as Learned Public Prosecutor.

At the outset, Learned Advocates of both sides state that no similar bail application is preferred, pending before or rejected by any Higher Court of law.

Rummaging the materials so far available, I find that the FIR was registered on 28.04.2026 over the incident happened on 27.04.2026.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioners that over the selfsame incident, both sides sustained injuries and there is counter case being Gangnapur PS Case No.103/2026 dated 28.04.2026.

Learned Public Prosecutor drew my attention to some medical papers and documents.

Perused the medical papers and documents.

Considered the submissions of both sides.

Perused the other materials on record and CD.

Considering the materials available in CD and being conceived by the submissions made by both sides, I am of the view that there is no need for custodial interrogation of the present petitioners, above named, for the purpose of investigation in this case.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail under section 482 of the BNSS stands **allowed**.

The petitioners, above named, are directed to **surrender before the Learned ACJM, Ranaghat within ten days** from this day of passing the order.

In case the **petitioners, above named,** surrender before the concerned Learned Court, each of them may find bail of **Rs.4000/-** with **two sureties** of Rs.2000/- each, subject to the **satisfaction of Learned ACJM, Ranaghat** and on **conditions** as is envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS, with further **direction** upon the **petitioners, above named,** that they will **meet the investigating officer twice in a week,** till the submission of report by the investigating officer.

CD and LCR be returned.

Criminal Misc. Case, is, thus, finally disposed of.
