The record is put up on prayer of the petitioners.

Petitioners, namely, **Bhagirath Das and Prasanta Das** file application through Learned Advocate praying for extension of time to surrender before the concerned Court, **vide order no.02 dated 01.07.2026** in the instant Criminal Misc Case, on the grounds stated in the petition.

The application is moved.

Heard both sides.

Learned Advocate for the petitioners has submitted that the period of surrender, as fixed, while allowing the anticipatory bail application in favour of the petitioners, should be extended to avail the opportunity of liberty granted by this Learned Court, as they could not surrender in time due to unavoidable circumstances.

Learned Public Prosecutor does not oppose the application.

Perused the application along with the order passed by this Court.

It appears from the record that petitioners **Bhagirath Das and Prasanta Das and others** have been granted anticipatory bail under section 482 of the BNSS **on 01.07.2026** in **Criminal Misc Case No.1250/2026** with direction to surrender before the concerned Court within **seven days** from the date of passing that order.

Considering the circumstances of the case and being conceived by the submissions made by both sides, the application is **allowed**.

Petitioners **Bhagirath Das and Prasanta Das** are directed to surrender before the concerned Court **within five working days from this date of passing the order**.

Petitioners may furnish bond accordingly.

Order No.02 dated 01.07.2026, passed in the instant Criminal Misc Case, **stands modified** to that extent only and other portions of that Order shall remain intact.
