Learned Advocate on behalf of accused **Khogen Das** submits that the accused has been falsely implicated in this case and has been languishing in custody for long. Investigation has proceeded much and seizure has already been completed. He is innocent and there is no chance of abscondance. Accordingly bail prayer may be considered.

Heard both sides.

Perused the bail petition along with other materials on record.

Learned Special P.P. has raised strong objection.

On perusal of the record it appears that this accused has been brought under arrest for commission of offence under sections 21(c) of NDPS Act. Contraband was seized about 25 bottles of **'Phensedyl' which is commercial quantity.** the investigation is going on. So, in view of the above and the serious impact of the offence upon the society and the provisions under section 37 of NDPS Act this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the accused, as prayed for.

Hence, the bail prayer is considered and **rejected.**
