The application for anticipatory bail **U/s 482 of the BNSS** filed on behalf of petitioner **Palash Nath** who apprehends arrest in connection with **Nabadwip P.S. Case No.867/2025** dated **10.12.2025** under **sections 316(2)/69/351(2) of the BNS, 2023** is taken up for hearing along with LCR and CD.

Heard Learned Advocate for the petitioner as well as Learned Public Prosecutor.

At the outset, Learned Advocates of both sides state that no similar bail application is preferred, pending before or rejected by any Higher Court of law.

Rummaging the materials so far available, I find that the FIR was registered on 10.12.2025 over the incident happened for last three years.

Defacto complainant acquainted with the principal accused through social media Facebook.

It is submitted that principal accused is on bail. Present petitioner is the brother of the said principal accused.

Considered the submissions of both sides.

Perused the materials on record and CD.

It is evident at this stage that charge sheet has been submitted in the meantime.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the view that detention of the present petitioner, above named, should be unnecessary, for the purpose of investigation in this case.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail under section 482 of the BNSS stands **allowed**.

The petitioner, above named, is directed to surrender before the Learned JM, Nabadwip within seven days from this day of passing the order.

In case the **petitioner, above named**, surrenders before the concerned Learned Court, he may find bail of **Rs.20000/-** and to that effect, the **petitioner, above named**, is directed to **execute Personal Bond** of the said amount of **Rs.20000/-**, on **conditions** as is envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. Bail Bond shall be accepted to the **satisfaction of the Learned JM, Nabadwip**, subject to the fulfillment of the **following conditions, ON AFFIDAVIT:**

1. That the petitioner **shall attend the Court on all scheduled dates** of hearing.
2. That the petitioner shall not cause any threat, induce, influence and intimidate the witnesses or tamper with evidence, in any manner, whatsoever.
3. That the **petitioner will execute affidavit before the IC/OC of the concerned PS**, stating therein that he shall not commit any other offence while remaining on bail and that he shall not misuse the liberty, granted.
4. That for the purpose of identification, the petitioner shall enclose a copy of their Aadhar Card/Voter Identity Card/PAN Card or any other valid document, issued by the Government authority, along with the Bail Bond.
5. That the bail, granted in respect of the petitioner, is purely temporary in nature and, in the event of violation of any of the conditions, mentioned here-in-above, his **bail shall be liable to be cancelled, automatically.**

Inform IC, Nabadwip PS, forthwith, with a copy of this Order.

CD and LCR be returned.

Criminal Misc. Case, is, thus, finally disposed of.
