01	13.06.24	Accused namely Sukdeb Bain @ Kalu is brought under arrest along with FIR, written complaint, seizure list, forwarding report, memo of arrest, to whom it may concern, accused challan and prayer for inventory. I.O prays for 10(Ten) days PC in respect of accused namely Sukdeb Bain @ Kalu. Accused Sukdeb Bain @ Kalu verbally prays for bail on the ground that he has been falsely implicated in this case and he is not in any way connected with this case. He also submits that he is a permanent resident within the jurisdiction of this Court and there is not chance of abscondance. So he prays for bail on any terms and conditions. Heard. Considered. It appears from the materials on record that 13 sacks and 28 petty's containing 6010 bottles of Phensedyl were recovered from the possession of the accused and during interrogation he confessed that he is a habitual smuggler. Considering the nature and gravity of the offence , prayer for bail is considered and rejected at this stage. I.O. is present before the Court today along with a prayer for police remand for 10 (ten) days and the said prayer was duly forwarded by Dy. S.P. (D & T) Krishnagar Police District. Ld. P.P. is present and forwarded the prayer for police remand for 10 (ten) days for the said accused person. Accused person is heard in person and he submits that he has no injury in his person. I.O. is present with the C.D. Heard both sides. Perused the entire materials on record. Considered. It appears that the prayer for PC for the accused has been duly forwarded by Dy. S.P. (D & T)Krishnagar Police District. The P.C. has been prayed to facilitate the investigation. It reflects that the PC if allowed will help in unearthing the truth and will drive the investigation in right direction. The prayer of the I.O. is thus allowed. The prayer for P.C. is allowed for 7 (seven) days.	

		NDPS NO, 54/2024 Order No, 01 (condt...) Dated, 13.06.2024 The I.O. is allowed to take the said accused persons in police custody for 7 (seven) days and is also directed to observe all formalities of the Hon’ble Apex Court while keeping the accused persons in police custody. During the period of remand of the accused person in P.C., the I.O. is directed to take due and proper care of the accused person and not to inflict any kind of torture upon the accused person and is further directed to make arrangement for medical check up of the accused person regularly by every 24 hours or as and when required, by observing due compliance of the guidelines given by the Hon’ble Apex Court in the case of D. K. Basu. To, 20.06.2024 for production of the accused persons along with medical report. The IO is hereby directed to remain present on the date fixed along with CD. IO is directed to take steps for inventory, sampling, certification and disposal of seized contraband under section 52A of the NDPS Act immediately regarding the sample of seized contraband before the concerned empowered learned Judicial Magistrate of the Sub-division where the concerned PS is located and to file a compliance report before this Court as soon as possible, in default, appropriate action will be initiated against the IO as per the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in this regard.
