Heard both sides.

Perused the bail petition along with other materials on record.

Learned Special P.P. has raised strong objection.

It appears from the record that the accused is the owner of the vehicle wherefrom huge quantity of contraband was recovered. The accused was arrested only on 30.10.2024. The accused is a resident of UP. The investigation is going on. If the accused be released on bail, there will be every chance of tampering with the evidence and there is every chance of absconson.

Considering the nature of offence and in view of the serious impact of the offence upon the society, and in view of the provisions under section 37 of NDPS Act and in view of the serious impact of the offence upon the society, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the accused.

Hence, the bail prayer is considered and **rejected**.
