**Order No.47 dated 25-09-2025**

Accused persons namely Sushil Kumar, Rajib Biswas, Bapon Halder, Rabi Kumar, Ratnesh Kumar, Lakshman Ghosh and Sona Dhara are produced from Correctional Home through VC and are represented by their respective Id.advocates.

Ld.Spl.PP is present.

Today is fixed for production and further order.

It is submitted by Id.Spl.PP that the report of execution regarding the attachment process had already been received in respect of accused persons namely Narottam Biswas, Sukdeb Biswas, Sushanta Ghosh, Lakshman Ghosh and Sona Dhara by this Court. It is submitted that the accused persons namely Lakshman Ghosh and Sona Dhara voluntarily surrendered before this Court on 18.08.2025 and since then they are lying in custody. It is further submitted that since the execution report about process of attachment had already been received against the other three accused persons namely Narottam Biswas, Sukdeb Biswas, Sushanta Ghosh, the case against them be filed for the present in order to proceed with the trial against the other accused persons.

Having heard Id.Spl.PP and considering the fact of execution report about process of attachment as issued against accused persons namely Narottam Biswas, Sukdeb Biswas, Sushanta Ghosh, for ends of justice the case against these three accused persons be filed for the present.

Now, Id.counsel representing accused Lakshman Ghosh and Sona Dhara points out the petition dt.18.08.2025 as fixed for hearing and the petition is taken up for that. It is simply contended by Id.counsel for the accused persons that the authenticated copy of CDR and SDR are to be supplied to the accused persons. Ld.Spl.PP submits that the stage of hearing of this case about supplying of copy has not yet arrived and if those copies are not supplied to them, then they can raise the point and at this stage the application is not at all maintainable.

After due consideration of the the submission of both the sides, I am of the view that the application cannot be taken at this stage for consideration as the copies have not yet been supplied to the accused persons of this case and on the next date if the copies are not supplied, then the accused persons can raise about the prayer for non-supplying of copies. Thus, the petition dt.18.08.2025 is kept in abeyance till next date of hearing of this case for supplying of copies.

Now, Id.counsel for accused Lakshman Ghosh points out another petition as submitted on 18.08.2025 and submits to hear out that petition for passing necessary order and the petition is taken up for that. In that petition it is simply averred that while executing the warrant of proclamation and attachment, some materials were seized, but the petitioner Lakshman Ghosh voluntarily surrendered before this Court and accordingly it is prayed that the seized materials be returned.

On perusal of the case record, particularly the execution report of attachment, it appears that a brown colour refrigerator and one light still grey colour show-case were seized by the executing officer from the wife of accused Lakshman Ghosh on 12.08.2025 in reference to Bhimpur PS Case No.190/24 dt.17.07.2024.

Perused the seizure list which signifies the seizure of the articles from the possession of one Jhuma Ghosh , the wife of accused Lakshman Ghosh.

Ld.Spl.PP very fairly submits that the purpose of prosecution to secure the attendance of the accused Lakshman Ghosh by declaring as proclaimed offender by attaching the movable properties has served as accused Lakshman Ghosh voluntarily surrendered before this Court on 18.08.2025 and the prosecution has no objection against release of those seized materials to the custody of the person from whom seized.

Admittedly, on 18.08.2025 accused Lakshman Ghosh voluntarily surrendered before this Court in reference to this case and since then he is lying in custody.

Having considered the submission of both the sides,the petition dt.18.08.2025 submitted on behalf of Lakshman Ghosh is allowed on contest.

Let the seized articles as per the seizure list dt.12.08.2025 in reference to the case, be released to the interim custody of Smt. Jhuma Ghosh, the wife of accused Lakshman Ghosh by furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- on condition not to dispose of the said materials till disposal of this case.

After hearing and considering further submission of ld.Spl.PP and all the ld.counsels representing the accused persons, the hearing of this case is adjourned till **15.12.2025** for production of the accused persons namely Sushil Kumar, Rajib Biswas, Bapon Halder, Rabi Kumar, Ratnesh Kumar, Lakshman Ghosh and Sona Dhara for supplying of copy.

The accused persons be remanded back to JC.

Let a copy of order be sent to OC, Bhimpur PS for information and compliance of order and to submit report by next date.

Inform ld.Spl.PP also.
