All the seven accused persons namely Sushil Kumar, Rajiv Biswas, Bapan Biswas, Ravi Kumar, Ratnesh Kumar, Laxman Ghosh and Sona Dhara are physically from correctional home as per direction and are represented by their ld.advocates.

Ld.Spl.PP is present.

Today is fixed for production of accused persons and supply of copy. Ld.Spl.PP submits that copies are ready to supply to the accused persons and accordingly copies are supplied to all the accused persons.

After hearing the submission of all the sides, let the hearing of the case be fixed on 22.01.2026 for production of the accused persons and consideration of charge.

At this stage an application seeking bail is filed on behalf of accused Ratnesh Kumar and is taken up for hearing. It is submitted by ld.counsel that he is lying in custody for a considerable period and he is quite innocent and did not commit any offence as alleged. . It is also submitted that there is no scope of abscondance, if he is bailed out and accordingly it is prayed to release him on bail on any condition

Heard ld.Spl.PP who raises severe objection on the ground that allegation against this accused and others is quite severe in nature and huge quantity of contraband materials (Phensedyl bottles) have been recovered and next date is fixed for consideration of charge and prosecution will proceed trial in accordance with law. Hence, it is submitted to reject the prayer for bail.

Heard both the sides. Perused the case record.

Having considered the submission of both the sides and taking into account the stage of hearing of the case and the nature and gravity of the allegation, I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail and the same is considered and rejected.

All the accused persons are remanded back to JC with a direction of production.
