Accused namely **Rajib Biswas and Bapan Halder** are produced from correctional home.

Report from I.O is not yet been received.

Received a close envelope (DVD) from PSI, Kazi Mohammed Aziz of Bhimpur PS Nadia. Let it be kept with the record.

Fix, **08.10.2024** for production and I.O's report.

Accused **Ravi Kumar** is produced before this Court on Transit Remand.

Learned Advocate for the accused namely **Ravi Kumar** files a petition praying for bail on the ground that the accused have been falsely implicated in this case. He is innocent and has no intention to evade the trial. So he prays for bail on any terms and conditions.

Learned special P.P. raised objection

Heard. Considered.

From the CD it appears that investigation is going on. It also appears that huge quantity of Phensedyl i.e. **20,000 bottles of Phensedyl** were recovered from the vehicle which was being driven by this accused and this accused is a resident of UP and he was arrested from Alipur. He was produced before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, North District Rohini Court, Delhi and was given in transit remand.

Considering the recovery of contraband and during interrogation it reveals that he drove the container vehicle from Gurgaon Haryana to deliver the contraband articles and he is directly involved in the offence and also considering the gravity of offence the bail prayer stands **rejected**.

I.O. is present before the Court today along with a prayer for further police remand for 7 (seven) days of the accused person **Ravi Kumar** and the said prayer was duly forwarded by the Dy. Superintendent of Police, IUCAW, Krishnagar PD.

Ld. Special P.P. is present and prays for further police remand of the accused person for 7 days.

Accused person is heard in person and he submits that he has no injury in his body.

I.O. is present with the C.D. Heard both sides.

Perused the entire materials on record.

Considered.

It appears that the prayer for PC for the accused person has been duly forwarded by the Dy. Superintendent of Police, IUCAW, Krishnagar PD. The P.C. has been prayed to facilitate the investigation. It reflects that the PC if allowed will help in unearthing the truth and to ascertain the involvement of the accused, the prayer is allowed.

The prayer of the I.O. is thus allowed.

The prayer for P.C. is allowed for 06 (Six) days.

The I.O. is allowed to take the said accused person in police custody for 06(Six) days and is also directed to observe all formalities of the Hon'ble Apex Court while keeping the accused persons in police custody.

During the period of remand of the accused person in P.C., the I.O. is directed to take due and proper care of the accused person and not to inflict any kind of torture upon the accused person and is further directed to make arrangement for medical checkup of the accused person regularly by every 24 hours or as and when required, by observing due compliance of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of D. K. Basu.

To, **01.10.2024** for production of the accused person along with medical report.

The IO is hereby directed to remain present on the date fixed along with CD.
