The accused person namely **Ravi Kumar** is produced before this court after completion 06 days P.C period as per early order dated,25.09.2024. Seen the Forwarding report of I.O, accused challan and medical slip .

He is taken into custody and remanded to J/C.

Learned Advocate on behalf of accused person **Ravi Kumar** files a petition praying for bail on the ground that the accused is detained in custody since long. He is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. There is no chance of abscondence.

Heard both sides.

Perused the bail petition along with other materials on record.

Learned Special P.P. has raised strong objection.

It appears from the record that the accused person was arrested for possessing **20000 bottles of Phensedyl** without any valid document which are commercial quantity when he came to delivery the same at Korsuna village under Bhimpur PS. He is the driver of the vehicle and a resident of UP. Investigation is going on. If the accused be released on bail, there is every chance of absconding. There is a racket of inter state trafficking of drugs. So, at this stage the Court is not inclined to grant him bail.

Considering the nature of offence, and as the contraband is commercial quantity and in view of the provisions under section 37 of NDPS Act and in view of the serious impact of the offence upon the society, this the bail prayer is considered and **rejected**.
