

The Investigating Officer Sri.Jagadeesh.R, Police Sub-Inspector of Baiyappanahalli Railway PS is present before me today i.e., on 01-10-2022 at 5.30 p.m.

The Narcotic substances are seized and reported to this court vide P.F.No.20/2022 in Cr.No.15/2022. The IO has given a requisition to certify the correctness of the inventory so prepared by him. He has come with Digital Weighing Machine.

He has furnished Annexure-I/Inventory of seized Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances.

Pancha witnesses by name Nagendra Swamy :HC No.118 and Srikanth : PC-324 of Baiyappanahalli Railway Police station are present. Srinivas Babu :HC-15, Baiyappanahalli Railway P.S is present with Vivo S-5 Mobile phone having camera. He has photographed the inventories certified at the chambers of XLI ACMM., Bengaluru.

The IO has produced the following article:

1] 3 sealed half white colored cloth covers having the seal of "BYPL RPS" and the slip containing the signatures of the witnesses and seizing officer. They are referred as article No.1 to 3 respectively.

I have perused the seal found on it. The seals are intact. It is weighed in my presence with seal.

The total weight of article No.1 is 1.550 Kg. The same is opened before me and in the presence of pancha witnesses. It contained Ganja. Out of that, 100 grams is separated for sending the same to chemical examination and to produce it before the court at the time of trial. Hence, sample of 100 grams of Ganja is packed with white colored cloth cover.

The total weight of article No.2 is 900 grams. The same is opened before me and in the presence of pancha witnesses. It contained Ganja. Out of that, 100 grams is separated for sending the same to chemical examination and to produce it before the court at the time of trial. Hence, sample of 100 grams of Ganja is packed with white colored cloth cover.

The total weight of article No.3 is 400 grams. The same is opened before me and in the presence of pancha witnesses. It contained Ganja. Out of that, 100 grams is separated for sending the same to chemical examination and to produce it before the court at the time of trial. Hence, sample of 100 grams of Ganja is packed with white colored cloth cover.

As this court is not provided with separate seal, the sample packs are sealed with “BYPL-RPS” and the slip containing the particulars such as, case number, signature of the witnesses, signature of the IO and the signature of the court is affixed. Sample packs are given numbers as S1 to S3 and the same is handed over to the Investigating officer.

Remaining Ganja found in article No.1 to 3 is again packed in the same covers, sealed and then handedover to the IO.
