Order No. 10 dt. 18.08.2025:

Today is the date fixed for evidence.

Two accused persons namely Sanjoy Das and Laxmi Das on court bail are present by filing hazira.

Another accused Deba Das is produced from J/C.

He is further remanded to J/C.

Prosecution files hazira of two witnesses.

P.W-10 and P.W-11 namely Dr. Basudeb Biswas and ASI Nirmalya Roy are examined and cross-examined in full respectively and discharged thereafter. During their examination the P.M report is marked as Exhibit- P/10 (P.W-10), Inquest report as Exhibit-P/1 (P.W-11) and dead body challan as Exhibit-P/11 (P.W-11) respectively.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/ accused Deba Das files a petition for bail.

The copy of the bail petition is served upon the Ld. PP in charge.

It is submitted that accused Deba Das is in custody for more than one year. It is further submitted that other co- accused persons on same footing are on bail and if the bail is granted to the petitioner/ accused, he shall not abscond or leave the jurisdiction of this Court. It is further submitted that the charge sheet in this case has already been submitted and custodial detention of the accused is not necessary for the purpose of the investigation of this case and most of the prosecution witnesses have also been examined in this case. Therefore, Ld. Advocate for the accused prays for grant for bail of petitioner/ accused Deba Das on any terms and conditions.

Ld. PP raises strong objection for grant of bail.

Heard both sides.

Perused the case record.

It appears that allegation is serious and specific against this accused person regarding his alleged involvement in committing the crime of abetting or instigating his wife to commit suicide by inflicting mental and physical torture upon her for demand of more dowry. It also appears that altogether 11 PWs have already been examined so far and I find that the some P.Ws have spoken about the involvement of the accused in the alleged offence. I further find that this accused is the husband of the victim and he is the prime accused in this case. So, in view of the seriousness of the allegation against the accused person and also the evidence of witnesses recorded so far in this case and also considering the nature of the offence, I am not inclined to

allow the prayer for bail. Therefore, the bail application of the accused Deba Das is considered and rejected.
