Criminal Misc. Case No. 952 of 2026

Order No. 05, dated 05.06.2026.

The application, praying for bail, under section **482 of the BNSS**, submitted on behalf of the accused/petitioners, viz. **Ananda Bhakta and Champa Biswas @ Bhakta**, who apprehend arrest, in connection with **Karimpur P.S Case No. 78/26, dated 12.04.2026, U/S 107/3(5) of the BNS**, is taken up for hearing.

At the outset, Ld. Defence counsel mentioned that no other bail application in respect of the accused/petitioners has been preferred or pending or rejected before any higher authority concerned.

I find that F.I.R was registered on **12.04.2026**, over the incident happened on **05.04.2026**.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that the pin point allegation is against one accused namely Amit Bhakta @ Abir Bhakta, and present petitioners are parents of said Amit Bhakta. Opinion form by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners is that said Amit is a minor and I.O was under obligation to transfer his case to the Juvenile Justice Board. But I am totally disagree with such view taken by him as it is evident that said Amit is over 17 years old and consideration under Section 15 of the Act is not subject matter hereof.

Rummaging the materials so far available. I find that the victim is a minor of 15 years 06 months and she committed suicide by hanging herself. Serious allegation against the accused person is that he obtained obscene pictures and started blackmailing the victim by imposing fear to upload the same in social media.

Perused the confidential statement given by the witnesses. Victim wrote anything and everything, happened with her at the instant of the accused persons. Involvement of the accused persons directly transpired and therefore, question of custodial interrogation is also there, but reason best known to the I.O, as to why thoroughfare has been given to the accused persons till this day.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail under **Section 482 of the BNSS is rejected**.

Return the C.D. and the L.C.R. at once.

Thus, the Criminal Misc. Case is hereby disposed of.
