Learned Additional PP for the State has requested to adjourn present bail application on the ground that the FSL report is yet to be received in the present case. At this stage, Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused has requested for release of applicant/accused on interim bail as FSL report is likely to take considerable period of time. In support of his contention, Ld. Counsel has relied upon judgment passed by Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in Inderjeet Singh versus State of Punjab 2014(3) RCR (Criminal) 953 (P & H).

2. Report from concerned police station forwarded by learned Additional PP for the State, was received to the effect that no other bail application/petition pertaining to present FIR is pending before any court.

3. I have given thoughtful consideration to the rival contentions and have also gone through the record of present case. Perusal of the record reveals that as per the allegations, on 02-06-2026, applicant/accused was apprehended by the police party and on checking 07 grams heroin was recovered from his possession. The FSL report is yet to be received and accused is in custody since 02-06-2026. Keeping in view above fact and the prayer of Id. Counsel for the applicant/accused, this court deems it fit to grant relief of interim bail to applicant/accused at this stage subject to the furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 30,000/- with one surety to the satisfaction of Ld. Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to the conditions that the applicant/accused will not try to tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner, will not leave the country without prior permission of the court, will appear on each and every date of hearing.

4. However, it is clarified that the bail so granted to the applicant/accused is subject to receipt of final chemical analysis report from the office of FSL or final police report, whichever is earlier. In case the relevant chemical report declares the alleged recovery falling in the category of commercial quantity, present bail order shall automatically stand cancelled and applicant/accused would be liable to surrender before the court. Surety of accused shall furnish an affidavit in that regard at the time of furnishing bonds assuring to get the accused surrendered before the court in abovesaid eventuality.

5. Copy of this order be also sent to the Incharge FSL with the direction that the report of analysis of the sample should be submitted on or before the date fixed. Investigation Officer is also directed to obtain the copy of this order dasti and to deliver it to the Incharge FSL. The applicant shall remain bound by the following conditions:-

1. that the applicant shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Ld.Ilaqa Magistrate till presentation of challan and thereafter without the permission of the trial-court;
2. that the applicant shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
3. that the applicant shall continue to cooperate with the investigating agency;
4. that the applicant shall regularly attend the hearings before the trial Court;

6. In case the applicant mis-uses the concession of bail by absenting from the proceedings, the Ld.Trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel this bail order. The present bail application file be annexed with the remand papers/challan file.
