This is an application U/s.483 BNSS filed by accused person namely **Aurangaeb  
Rahaman Saha Fakir @ Orangajeb Rahaman Sa Fakir**.

Hd. Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner and Ld. PP-In-Charge.

The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused person/petitioner submits that the petitioner was arrested and produced before the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M. Tehatta on 21.12.2025 and since then, he has been in custody and no application u/s 483 of BNSS is pending in any higher forum of Law. He prays for bail of his client mainly on the ground of his innocence and detention.

Ld. PP-In-Charge raises vehement objection.

Perused the C.D. & T.C.R. including the FIR, the statements of witnesses recorded u/s 180 BNSS, statement of the VG recorded u/s 183 BNSS, medical examination report, injury report, seizure lists and CS.

This is a case u/s 109/115(2)/117(2)/126(2)/3(5)/64 of BNS.

It appears that CS has already been submitted in this case and so custodial interrogation of the accused is no longer required. On the other hand, the accused has been languishing in jail since 21.12.2025

Considering the above facts and the period of detention already undergone by the accused, this Court finds it justified to allow the petitioner for bail. The accused person /petitioner namely **Aurangaeb Rahaman Saha Fakir @ Orangajeb Rahaman Sa Fakir** may find bail of **Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of Rs.5000/- each** to the satisfaction of Ld. A.C.J.M. Tehatta with condition to appear regularly before the Court, and with further condition that he shall not intimidate the witnesses and tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

C.D. & T.C.R. be returned.

The Misc. Case stands disposed of.
