This is an application U/s.483 BNSS filed by accused person namely **Pintu Sk**.
Hd. Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner and Ld. PP-In-Charge.

The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused persons/petitioners submits that the petitioner was arrested and produced before the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M. Tehatta on 21.02.2026 and since then, he has been in custody and no application u/s 483 of BNSS is pending in any higher forum of Law. He prays for bail of his client mainly on the ground of his innocence and detention.

Ld. PP-In-Charge raises objection.

Perused the C.D. & T.C.R. including the FIR, the statements of witnesses recorded u/s 180 BNSS and seizure list.

This is a case u/s 310(4)/310(5) of BNS.

Considering the nature of allegations, materials in CD, stagnant condition of investigation since the arrest of the accused person and period of detention already undergone by the accused person / petitioner, this Court finds it justified to allow the petition for bail. The accused person/petitioner **Pintu Sk** may find bail of **Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of Rs.5,000/- each** to the satisfaction of Ld. A.C.J.M. Tehatta with condition to appear regularly before the Court, and with further condition that he shall not intimidate the witnesses and shall not tamper with investigation in any manner whatsoever.

C.D. & T.C.R. be returned.

The Misc. Case stands disposed of.
