This is an application for anticipatory bail u/s.482 of BNSS on behalf of petitioners namely **Sukumar Das, Laxmi Das @ Lakshmi Das, Sonali Das, Bishnu Das and Dipankar Das**.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and the Ld. Spl. PP-In-Charge.

The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused persons/petitioners submits that the instant case is under Sections-65(1) of BNS & Section 06 of the POCSO Act. Ld. Advocate for the accused / petitioner submits that the principal accused is already on bail. Contending the aforesaid facts, Ld. Defence Counsel prays for anticipatory bail of the petitioners on the ground of their innocence.

Heard Ld. Spl. PP-in-Charge and he raises objection against the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the case record, CD, FIR, statement of witnesses recorded u/s 180 BNSS, statement of the VG recorded u/s 183 BNSS and seizure list.

This is a case u/s 65(1) BNS & Section 06 of POCSO Act.

Considering the nature of allegations levelled against the accused persons praying for bail, the fact that the principal accused is already on bail, it appears that detention of the accused persons / petitioners is not necessary for further proceedings in this case. Accordingly, this Court finds it justified to allow their prayer for anticipatory bail.

It is directed that in the case of arrest, the arresting officer shall release petitioners **Sukumar Das, Laxmi Das @ Lakshmi Das, Sonali Das, Bishnu Das and Dipankar Das** on their furnishing bond of **Rs.10,000/- each with two RS of Rs.5,000/- each** of the amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer on condition to comply the conditions as enshrined in Section-482(2) of BNSS.

C.D. & C.R. of POCSO Case be returned.

The Misc. Case stands disposed of. Inform the concerned OC.
