This is an application U/s.483 BNSS filed by accused person namely **Balai Roy @ Balaram Roy**.

Hd. Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner and Ld. PP-In-Charge.

The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused person/petitioner submits that the petitioner was arrested and produced before the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M. Tehatta on 09.03.2026 and since then, he has been in custody and no application u/s 483 of BNSS is pending in any higher forum of Law. He prays for bail of his client mainly on the ground of his innocence and detention.

Ld. PP-In-Charge raises objection.

Perused the C.D. & T.C.R. including the FIR, the statements of witnesses recorded u/s 161 CrPC, statement of VG recorded u/s 164 of CrPC, seizure list and CS.

This is a case u/s 363/366/34 of BNS.

It appears from the record that CS has already been submitted in this case after completion of investigation. It also appears that two other accused persons standing in the same footing as that of the present accused, have already been granted anticipatory bail by the Ld. Sessions Judge, Nadia.

Considering the nature of allegations against the petitioner, the period of detention already undergone by the accused person / petitioner and also considering that CS has already been submitted in this case after completion of investigation, this Court finds it justified to allow the petition for bail. The accused person/petitioner **Balai Roy @ Balaram Roy** may find bail of **Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of Rs.5,000/- each** to the satisfaction of Ld. A.C.J.M. Tehatta with condition to appear regularly before the Court, and with further condition that he shall not intimidate the witnesses and shall not tamper with investigation in any manner whatsoever.

C.D. & T.C.R. be returned.

The Misc. Case stands disposed of.
