Today is fixed for reconciliation of the parties. Both parties are physically in Court along with their Ld. Advocates.

The case record is taken up for reconciliation. This court took its best endeavour to reconcile the dispute between them, but parties are too arrogant to settle the dispute between them. Hence, reconciliation fails.

Now, the petition u/s.13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act is taken up for hearing.

The petitioners No.1 and No.2 file their deposition by way of an affidavit and further examined on dock as PW-1 and PW-2 in full and discharged. Photo copy of Adhar cards (on comparison with original) of the respective parties and one certificate dated 18.07.2025 issued by Pradhan of Karimpur-II GP, PO Karimpur, PS Karimpur, Nadia regarding marriage of the parties have been marked as Ext.1, Ext 2 and X for identification respectively.

This is an application u/s.13B(1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

It transpires that the marriage between the petitioners has been solemnized on **26.02.2016** according to Hindu Rites and Customs and after which the parties resided as husband and wife. It further appears that since **29.03.2022** parties have been living separately and there is no chance of reconciliation and the parties have no other alternative but to break their marriage tie and that there is no collusion between the parties and there is no claim whatsoever against each other.

Therefore, in view of above, this court is of view that there is no impediment in passing a decree of divorce on mutual consent.

C.F. paid is correct.

Hence, it is,

**ORDERED,**

that the Mat. Suit No. **104/2025** be and the same is decreed on consent in favour of the petitioners, but without any order as to costs.

The marriage tie between the parties, namely, **Sumitra Mondal** and **Uttam Mandal @ Mondal** solemnized on **26.02.2016** according to Hindu Rites and Customs, is hereby dissolved on mutual consent u/s.13B(1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 with effect from the date of decree.

Let, a copy of this order be supplied to each of the parties free of cost as per provision of section 23(4) of the Hindu Marriage Act.
