

Order dt. 03.12.2018

The record is taken up before this Court by filing a put up petition on behalf of the accused persons.

Another petition has been filed on behalf of the accused persons praying for making payment of Rs. 2000/- each (Total 4,000/-) with the Judicial Cashier.

Heard. Considered.

It appears that vide this Court's order dt. 22.03.2018, both the accused persons were sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 2000/- each along with one year SI under Section 14 of the Foreigners Act, 1946.

Hence, the petition is allowed.

Accused persons are directed to deposit the said amount (Rs. 4,000/-) with the Judicial Cashier.

Judicial Cashier is directed to receive the said amount and to forward the same towards the Government Treasury.
