Today is fixed for production of the accused & evidence on behalf of prosecution.

Ld. PP-In-Charge as well as Ld. Advocate for the accused is present.

Accused is produced from the JC.

Witness Sweet Das is present, who is examined and is cross-examined in full as PW6 and is discharged.

The evidence was recorded in English. Hard copy of the testimony so recorded duly signed will be a true copy by the BC-I has been made available free of cost against receipt to the Ld. Advocate of the accused, to the witness and the Ld. PP-In-Charge as per Rule-135(3) of the Code Criminal (Subordinate Court Rules) 1985 as amended vide Hon'ble High Court's Notification No.2301-G Dated 14.07.2022.

One bail petition on behalf of the accused is filed. Copy served and objected to.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused as well as Ld. PP-In-Charge.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submitted that the accused is custody since 01.03.2025. The evidence of public witnesses has already been completed. There are major contradictions in the evidence recorded so far. In view of detention prayed for bail.

On the other hand, Ld. PP-In-Charge raised strong objection and prayed for rejection of bail prayer.

Considering the materials available in the record, I find this is a case u/s.6 of POCSO Act and on 10.09.2025 during trial of this case the bail petition of this accused/petitioner was turned down by this Court with certain observations. I find there is not significant change of circumstance since last rejection of bail prayer of this accused. The trial of this case is now at its full swing. Considering all aspects, this is not a fit case to grant bail to this accused at this stage.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the accused is hereby rejected.

To **19.05.2026** for further evidence and production of the accused.

Accused is remanded to the JC with a direction to produce on the next date fixed.

Issue summons accordingly.
