Criminal Misc Case No.130/2026 (R-130/2026)

Order No.03 dated 01.07.2026.

This is an application under section 439 of Cr.P.C. corresponding to **U/s.483 of the BNSS**, filed by accused/petitioner Biplob Sk, who is in custody regarding Ranaghat-PS Case No.320 of 2026 Dated 16.05.2026 u/s.281/106(2) of BNS is taken up for hearing along with TCR & CD.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner submitted that this accused/petitioner was driver of the offending vehicle and the victims died due to a Road Traffic Accident. The victims were not known to the accused/petitioner and no intention to cause any harm to the victims. The accused/petitioner is in custody since 21.05.2026. By submitting above, he prayed for bail.

On the other hand, Ld. PP-In-Charge objecting the bail application submitted that the investigation reveals involvement of the accused/petitioner with the alleged offence. Accordingly, he prayed for rejection of bail application.

Perused the case diary and TCR.

Considering the submission made by Ld. Advocate for the accused person as well as Ld. PP-In-Charge and in view of materials available in case diary, I find that the accused/petitioner was the driver of the offending vehicle and there is an allegation of rash and negligent driving. The investigation of the case has been progressed substantially. The accused is in custody for a considerable period. Till date the investigation does not reveal in clear cut manner that the accused petitioner had any intention to cause harm to the victims. Considering all aspect, I think for the purpose of investigation the further detention of the accused is not required. So, in view of detention and substantial progress in investigation, I think prayer for bail application of this accused may be granted.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the prayer for bail of the accused Biplob Sk is allowed. The accused Biplob Sk may find bail of Rs.5,000/- with one registered surety, subject to satisfaction of the Ld. ACJM, Ranaghat and on condition to meet the IO once in a fortnight for next 3 months.

Inform Ld. ACJM, Ranaghat by sending a copy of the instant order.

CD and TCR be returned.

Criminal Misc. Case, is, thus, finally disposed of.
