Both the petitioners of this case are present by filing haziras.

This day is fixed for evidence and for passing order. Record is taken up accordingly.

They have filed their respective affidavit-in-chiefs, which are tendered in evidence as PW1 & PW2. Aadhaar cards of respective parties have been marked as Ext.1 to Ext.2. Heard Ld. Advocates for both petitioners. Perused the materials on record. Reconciliation has already failed and it appears that there is no chance of their reunion further.

Considered.

It appears from the joint application under section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act supported with an affidavit and from the affidavit in chief filed before this Court and the exhibits that the marriage took place on 17.01.2023 according to Hindu Rites and Customs between both the petitioners i.e wife and husband and they are residing separately since 18.07.2023 and they have not been able to live together as husband and wife due to differences of opinion, taste and culture and that they have mutually agreed that the marriage should be dissolved. Under such circumstances, I find no impediment to allow the instant application when the parties to this case are unable to live together as husband wife and they have mutually agreed to end their nuptial tie and their such decision is voluntary.

C.F paid is sufficient.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the instant Mat. Suit No.889 of 2025 is decreed on mutual consent, u/s.13B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

Accordingly, the marriage between the petitioner No.1/husband namely **Sri Subhajit Sarkar** and the petitioner No.2/wife namely **Smt. Runa Sarkar (Mondal)** solemnised on 17.01.2023 stands dissolved from this day, u/s.13B of the Hindu Marriage Act.
