

**POCSO Case No.12(02)2022
R - 102 of 2022**

Today is fixed for production of the accused and for hearing of the argument.

The accused Nemaï Pramanick is produced from the JC.

Ld. PP-In-Charge submits a written argument along with some case Laws.

A bail petition is filed on behalf of the accused.

Copy served.

Objection raised.

The bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Heard. Perused and considered.

It appears that the accused is FIR named with an allegation that he had committed penetrative sexual assault upon the victim girl after taking her to the house of Tukai Sikder, where no family members of the house owner was present.

From the evidence on record as appears, several incriminating materials have come out against the accused to show his involvement in the offence.

Considering the nature of offence and the complicity of the accused therein, bail petition stands **rejected**.
