**Order No. 05 dated 10.03.2026:**

Today is fixed for passing ex parte order.

Petitioner **Goutam Pundari** is present filing by attendance through his Ld. Counsel.

Heard the Ld. Counsel for petitioner.

Considered the submissions and perused the record.

The case record is taken up for the above purpose.

This is an application filed by the petitioner u/s 13(1) of Hindu Marriage Act 1955 for dissolution of his marriage with the respondent, by a decree of divorce on the ground of desertion and cruelty.

The marriage between the petitioner and respondent was solemnized on **04.02.2021** according to Hindu rites and customs from the paternal house of the respondent that situates at Kalamari, PO- Kalamari, PS- Hanskhali, Dist. Nadia. After the marriage, the petitioner and respondent started residing together as spouses at the house of the petitioner that situates at Majidpur, Dakshinpara, PS Hanskhali, Dist, Nadia. It is further stated by the petitioner that in the said wedlock, no child was born.

It is the further case of the petitioner, that the respondent failed to do any household work and her demand was vast which the petitioner was unable to provide and he was tortured physically and mentally by the respondent and on **31.03.2021** the respondent left her matrimonial home voluntarily. The petitioner has further stated that since then, he is residing separately from the respondent and he is under the apprehension that the matrimonial relation between him and the respondent shall never revive in the shape of normal conjugal relationship, and as such he has filed the instant case for dissolution of marriage with the respondent by decree of divorce on the ground of cruelty and desertion.

The Respondent **Barnali Pundari @ Biswas**, after receiving of summon did not turn up before this Court and hence, this suit proceeded exparte against the respondent.

The petitioner, **Goutam Pundari** examined himself as **P.W.-1**. He submitted his examination in chief on affidavit, and by tendering the same on the dock conveyed and corroborated her case, as made out in the plaint and the factum of cruelty and desertion by

the respondent **Barnali Pundari @ Biswas**. The oral testimony of the petitioner as P.W.-1 remains unchallenged and uncontroverted from any quarter.

In absence of any contrary and controverting evidence on record and as the evidence of the petitioner as PW-1 remains unchallenged and un-controverted, this Court finds its apt to allow the prayer of the petitioner, filed u/s 13(1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, for divorce on the ground of cruelty and desertion.

C.F paid is correct.

Hence it is

**ORDERED**

That the application u/s.13 of Hindu Marriage Act filed on 28.03.2025 being **MAT Suit no. 326/2025 (CIS 371/2025)** is allowed exparte, but without any order as to costs.

The marriage solemnized between the parties namely **Goutam Pundari and Barnali Pundari @ Biswas** on **04.02.2021** according to Hindu rites and customs is hereby dissolved by decree of divorce with effect from this day.

Let a copy of this order be given free of cost to the petitioner **Goutam Pundari**.

Decree be drawn up accordingly.
