Order No. 06 dated 10.03.2026:

Today is fixed for passing ex parte order.

Petitioner **Piyasha Kundu @ Ram** is present filing by attendance through her Ld. Counsel.

Heard the Ld. Counsel for petitioner.

Considered the submissions and perused the record.

The case record is taken up for the above purpose.

This is an application filed by the petitioner u/s 25(i) of the Special Marriage Act for a decree of nullity of her marriage registered with the respondent.

The marriage between the petitioner and respondent was registered on **28.01.2023** under the Special Marriage Act, before the Marriage Officer Bapin Ch. Das. It is the further case of the petitioner that after registration of their marriage, she never went to the house of the respondent and neither cohabited with him at any place. It is the further case of the petitioner that after registration of marriage there was no social marriage held between them and they did not reside together under one roof as spouses. The petitioner has further stated that after registration of the said marriage, she and the respondent went to their respective paternal houses and has been residing there till date. The petitioner has explicitly stated that her registered marriage with the respondent was never consummated as she did not reside together with him and because there was no cohabitation between them. The petitioner has stated that their registered marriage could not be consummated due to willful refusal by the respondent. Since the registration of the said marriage, the petitioner is residing separately from the respondent and she is under the apprehension that her matrimonial relation with the respondent shall never revive in the shape of normal conjugal relationship, as the respondent willfully refused to consummate the marriage and to lead a conjugal life with her at his house and as such she has filed the instant case for severing her marital tie with the respondent by a decree of nullity of her marriage registered on **28.01.2023** under the Special Marriage Act.

The Respondent **Amit Kumar Ram**, after due receipt of notice of this instant matrimonial suit at first appeared before the Court but later on did not turn up before the Court and hence this suit proceeded ex parte against him.

The petitioner, **Piyasha Kundu @ Ram** examined herself as P.W.-1. She submitted her examination in chief on affidavit and by tendering the same on the dock conveyed and corroborated her case. She also proved the registration of her marriage with the respondent by submitting the original certificate of registration which was marked as **Exhibit P1**. The oral testimony of the petitioner as P.W.-1 remains unchallenged and uncontroverted from any quarter. P.W 1 duly proved that after registration of her marriage with the respondent, there was no consummation of the said marriage between them due to willful refusal by the respondent.

In absence of any contrary and controverting evidence on record and as the evidence of the petitioner as PW1 remains unchallenged and un-controverted, this Court finds its apt to allow the prayer of the petitioner, filed u/s 25 (i) of Special Marriage Act, for a decree of nullity of her marriage registered with the respondent on **28.01.2023**.

C.F paid is correct.

Hence it is

ORDERED

That the application u/s. 25(i) of Special Marriage Act filed on 07.10.2024 being MAT Suit no. 956/2024 (CIS 995/2025) is allowed ex parte against the respondent **Amit Kumar Ram** , but without any order as to costs.

The marriage registered between the parties namely **Piyasha Kundu @ Ram and Amit Kumar Ram** on 28.01.2023 hereby stands dissolved by a decree of nullity with effect from this day.

The marriage registration certificate being no. 200701 dated 28.01.2023 issued by the Marriage Officer Bapin Ch. Das stands canceled with immediate effect.

Let a copy of this order be given free of cost to the petitioner **Piyasha Kundu @ Ram**.

Decree be drawn up accordingly.
