This petition was originally numbered as MCOP 80/2021 before Sub Court, Sivakasi(MACT) and subsequently transferred to this Court on its constitution and came up before me for final hearing on 05.09.2024 in the presence of Mr.A.Rathinavel Pandithurai, Counsel for the Petitioners; Thiru.R.Johnkennedy, Counsel for 2nd Respondent; and the 1st Respondent remained exparte and upon hearing both sides and on perusal of case records and having stood over before me for consideration till this day, this tribunal delivers the following:-

DECREETAL ORDER

(i) This petition is hereby allowed;

(ii) The petitioners are awarded compensation of Rs. 21,80,870/- with interest at the rate of 7.5 % from the date of filing petition to till the date of realisation;

(iii) The 2nd Respondent is directed to deposit the entire compensation amount in this Tribunal's Bank Account in Account No.42563580678, with State Bank of India, Sattur, within a period of 2 Months;

(iv) In the said total compensation amount, 1st petitioner is entitled for 15,80,870/-; the 2nd petitioner is entitled to withdraw Rs.3,00,000/- and the 3rd petitioner(now major) is entitled to withdraw Rs.3,00,000/- with interest as per their apportionment;

(v) Upon such deposit, all the petitioners are permitted to withdraw the entire compensation amount with accrued interest;

(vi) The petitioners are directed to deposit the court fees of Rs.21,181/-of this petition within two weeks from the date of this order if not already deposited;

(vii) The Advocate fees fixed as Rs.28,809/-.
