ORDER

03.07.2026 By filing a petition learned counsel for the accused-petitioners have submitted that the accused-petitioners, namely, **Usha Devi, Anil Kumar** have been granted anticipatory bail by this court vide order dated 01.06.2026 passed in A.B.P. No. 1991/2026 with direction to surrender before the learned court below within four weeks. Further submits that condition no.4 of the anticipatory bail order requires that one of the bailors shall be a family member of the petitioners. Further submits that the entire family members of the petitioners have been made accused in the present case and therefore, it has become impossible for the petitioners to comply with the said condition. Consequently, they could not surrender and file their bail bonds in the learned court below. Hence prayed that the condition no. 4 relating to the family bailor may be modified by the “relative” in place of family member. Further prayed that the time for surrender and furnishing bail bonds before the Ld. Court below may also be extended.

Heard. Perused the case record. Learned A.P.P. concedes the aforesaid facts.

Considering the aforesaid facts the prayer of the accused-petitioners is allowed. Accordingly the order dt. 01.06.2026 passed in ABP 1991/2026 stands modified to the extent that the condition no. 4 requiring one of the bailors to be a family member is substituted with the word “relative”. Accused-petitioners are directed to surrender in the learned court below and file their bail bonds till 29.07.2026 Accordingly, the petition filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners stands **disposed of**.
