Accused Md. Saukat Ali on bail is present.

The learned advocate for the accused has submitted that the prosecution was given sufficient opportunities, but no result has yielded. Since 1997 prosecution could examine three out of 12 witnesses named in the charge-sheet and on 27.09.2023 a schedule was framed, but prosecution did not comply it and the case should be closed and the accused person should get the benefit.

No step is taken by the prosecution.

This is an old case of 2004. No significant development is noticed since 06.05.2011.

In view of the ratio in Chakina Khatun - vs - State of West Bengal and another reported in CRR No. 854 of 2011 the Inspector-in-charge of Barasat P.S. is directed to secure presence of the witnesses named above and for production of seized articles on the dates fixed.

Let a copy of this order with a forwarding letter be sent to the District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas for appointment of one public prosecutor for conduct of the case properly and expeditiously.

The learned District P.P. is also requested to engage one learned advocate for conduct of the prosecution case.

The case is adjourned.
