Record is put up today on the prayer of the learned advocate for the accused Abdul Karim Sahaji.

A petition is filed on behalf of the said accused person praying for discharging the said accused person in terms of compromise dated 08.03.2025 between the said accused person and competent authority of the WBSEDCL before the Lok Adalat.

The accused Abdul Karim Sahaji files one money receipt of Rs.3,000/- being receipt No.129205859204 dated 23.06.2025 issued by the WBSEDCL.

Learned advocate for the accused person is present.

Learned P.P.-in-charge of this case is present.

Learned advocate for the WBSEDCL is present.

On consent of all the parties the said petitions filed on behalf of the accused person is taken up for hearing.

I have heard the submissions of the learned advocate for the said accused person, learned Public Prosecutor-in-charge of this case, learned advocate for the WBSEDCL and perused the records. From the records, it is revealed that the accused person and competent authority compounded the case before the Lok Adalat, that was happened on 08.03.2025 and the said accused person has deposited the compounded amount to the WBSEDCL, and in that respect one money receipt has been filed before this court.

Considering that the allegations against the said accused person is compoundable, and the said accused person and competent authority of the WBSEDCL compounded the said case and the WBSEDCL accepted the said agreed amount and no objection of the learned advocate for the WBSEDCL and the learned Public Prosecutor-in-charge of this case, I am of the view that it will be justified to acquit the said accused person, namely, Abdul Karim Sahaji from this case.

With above observation petition dated 24.06.2025 filed by the accused person Abdul Karim Sahaji is allowed.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the accused Abdul Karim Sahaji is acquitted from this case.

The case shall proceed against another accused.

To date (09.03.2026) for appearance of the accused Hasem Ali Molla and consideration of charge.
