Accused Mahesh Kumar Yadav and Swapan Kumar Roy are produced before this court. They are taken into custody.

The IO is present before this court and prays for police custody for fourteen days for both accused persons.

On going through the forwarding report I find that there is a recommendation for police custody for fourteen days but there is no seal as to who is the person who has recommended the same . The designation is also conspicuously absent beneath the said initial signature. Law mandates that police custody can be granted only when the same is recommended and forwarded by a higher police personnel of the district or the police administration but in this case it is not clear before this court as to who had made such recommendation.

Further on being asked the IO to produced the CD for consideration of PC prayer, he produces some loose sheets. None of the pages are paginated or the documents which has been handed over to this court by the IO does not appears to be the CD as prescribed under the law. For future reference all the pages are paginated by this court by putting seal and stamp forty pages.

Considering the fact that the materials on record and documents submitted by the IO are not in proper form and also the prayer of PC has been made in a casual manner and the investigation so far made does not inspire the confidence of this court to grant police custody.

Hence, the prayer for police custody is rejected at this stage.

The Learned Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court, Barasat, is directed to certify the correctness of inventory which is prepared by the IO of the seized narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances, controlled substances and equipments, the correctness of the list of samples so drawn.

The Learned Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court, Barasat is hereby directed further to send to this Court a copy of the documents prepared by him at the time of preparation of the said inventory for information of this Court.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the The Learned Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court, Barasat for his information and to the I.O of this Court for information.

The concerned IO of this case is also hereby directed to appear before the Learned Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court, Barasat for fixing a day for such purpose.

Seen another prayer of IO praying for disposal of sixty bags of potatoes which has been seized as those are perishable in nature. As potatoes are perishable in nature the IO is at liberty to dispose of the same as per law.

It further appear from the record that accused persons were produced on 02.02.2026 before Ld. CJM, Barasat, North 24 Parganas at 06:30 P.M by bypassing this court though this court was in sessions on 02.02.2026. There is no explanation even as to what prompted the IO to produce the accused before the Ld. CJM at 06:30 P.M on 02.02.2026, when the accused persons were arrested on 02.02.2026 at 11:10 hrs and 11:15 hrs respectively.

An explanation is sought for from the IO as to what necessitated him to take such step for production before Ld. CJM, Barasat, North 24 Parganas.

Perused the medical report of Md. Jalaluddin Shah. His eco-cardiography is scheduled on 4.2.2026. His blood test is scheduled on 30.01.2026. As such P.C prayer of 2 days is allowed on condition that his scheduled blood test is done on 30.01.2026.

I.O is directed not to inflict any torture upon the accused person namely, Md. Jalaluddin Shah and she is further directed to abide by the guidelines of Hon'ble Apex Court as made in the case of D.K. Basu Vs. Union of India. He is further directed to follow the guidelines of Human Rights Commission of India in its letter and spirit.

The I.O is further directed to make necessary arrangement for medical check up for the accused Md. Jalaluddin Shah every 24 hours during the P.C Period.
