Order no. 04 dated 16.03.2026:

The instant application u/s. 483 B.N.S.S filed by the petitioner, **Bablu Yadav** in c/w Bidhannagar South P.S. case No.03/2026 dated 02.01.2026 u/s.318(4)/336(3)/338 of B.N.S is taken up for hearing and order.

L.C.R received. C.D is also produced.

Heard the learned advocate for the petitioner accused and the learned P.P In-charge.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R and that two co-accused persons were granted bail by the court of Ld. A.C.J.M, Bidhannagar and that the person in whose account the amount was credited is still under custody and that the petitioner is a driver by profession and that the petitioner has been languishing in custody since 03.01.2026 i.e for a reasonable time and that the petitioner is not in any way connected with the alleged offence and he has permanent hearth and home and he will not abscond in any way and as such there is no justification for further detention of the accd person and that the petitioner is ready to cooperate with the investigation and to face the trial. He further submits that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail of the accused petitioner on any condition as deemed fit.

Raising strong objection, Ld. P.P in charge submits that the allegations are grave. Learned Public Prosecutor in charge opposed the bail prayer of the said accused person, relying on the materials in the C.D, including statements of witnesses recorded under Section 180 of B.N.S.S and submitted that allegations against the said accused person are very serious. He prays for rejecting the bail prayer of said accused person.

Perused the C.D. Considered.

The principal accused Arindam Mitrais is in custody. Other co-accused persons namely Md. Shahnawaz @ Prince and Zubair Khursid Ajhamad @ Junaid are on bail. Investigation is on stagnant stage.

Considering the period of detention of the present accused and the stage of investigation, the prayer for bail is allowed.

The petitioner namely **Bablu Yadav** may find bail upon furnishing bond of Rs 5,000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. A.C.J.M, Bidhannagar, North 24 Parganas, on condition that he shall not commit any offence while on bail and that he shall appear before the Ld. Court below on each and every date and in case of malafide absence of the petitioner, the Id Court below may cancel the bail without any reference to this Court.

Return the L.C.R along with a copy of this order to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D be returned.

The instant C.M.C is disposed of.
