Order no. 02 dated 05.03.2026:

The instant application u/s. 483 of B.N.S.S filed by the petitioner, **Anirban Nag** in c/w Gobardanga P.S. case No11/2026 dated 09.01.2026 u/s.25(i)(a)/27 of Arms Act is taken up for hearing and order.

L.C.R has been received. C.D is also produced.

Heard the learned advocate for the petitioner accused and the learned P.P In-charge.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been detained in custody for a considerable period of time and that he has been falsely implicated in this case and the arms were wrongly shown as recovered from him. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that after arrest on 10.01.2026 he was taken on remand which did not lead to any further recovery and that he has been languishing in custody ever since and that the petitioner was not involved in the alleged incident and that the petitioner is a local resident and as such there is no chance of his abscontion. He further submits that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail of the accused petitioner on any condition as deemed fit. .

Ld. P.P in charge raises strong objection, by placing the seizure list and submits that he is the accd of a grave crime.

Hd. Perused. Considered.

Considering the statement available in C.D and other materials, I am of the opinion that so far the allegations under section 25(i)(a)/27 of Arms Act are concerned, there is no tangible and sufficient of that against the petitioner. Besides this, the investigation has proceeded well and recovery has already been made.

On the ground as above and considering the period of detention, I am inclined to allow petitioner's bail prayer.

The petitioner namely **Anirban Nag** may find bail upon furnishing bond of Rs 5,000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M, North 24 Parganas, Barasat on condition that he shall not commit any offence while on bail and that he shall appear before the Ld. Court below on each and every date and in case of malafide absence of the petitioner, the ld Court below may cancel the bail without any reference to this Court.

Return the L.C.R.

Thus, the Cr. Misc. Case is disposed of.
