(Section 221, 222, 223 Code of Criminal Procedure)

1. Name and office of :- I, Shri Saugata Chakraborty, Addl Sessions Judge,
Magistrate & Court 4th Court, Barasat, North 24 – Parganas.

2. Name of accused
person hereby charge Bikash Marandi
you as follows :

First,

That you for the last four years six months calculated from 27.08.2018 which was the day of filing FIR, pretended to be the husband of the prosecutrix (name withheld) on the pretext of courtship and on promise of marriage abused her physically being in sexual relationship and that you knowingly did exploit her sexually deceiving the prosecutrix fraudulently and induced her to handover the valuables belonging to her in your favour and damaged her reputation in the society and damaged her emotionally and mentally and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under section 417 of Indian Penal Code
and within the cognizance of this Court of Sessions.

Secondly,

That you since 2014 committed rape on the prosecutrix after deceitfully imposing yourself before her as a person in a position of trust and committed rape repeatedly on her and that you thereby committed an offence punishable under section 376 of Indian Penal Code.

and within the cognizance of this Court of Sessions

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this Court on the said charges.

The charge so framed has been read over and explained to the accused and he has pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried.

Accused Bikash Marandi on bail is present.

Learned PP-in-charge and the learned defence advocate are present.

The case record is taken up for consideration of charge.

I have perused the FIR, charge sheet, case diary and other materials on record.

I have heard the learned PP-in-charge.

Prosecution has brought allegations under sections 417/376 of the IPC against the accused Bikash Marandi.

Upon consideration and hearing of the prosecution and the defence, I find that there is sufficient ground for proceeding. The allegations under section 417/376 of the IPC are *prima facie* established against the accused person.

The substance of accusations have been read over and explained to the accused person and he pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried.

A formal charge in Form 32, Schedule- II of the Code of Criminal Procedure is prepared and is on record.
