(National Lok Adalat held on 27/07/2024)

Complainant is present along with his/its learned advocate in National Lok Adalat. Complainant has filed pursis at Exh.4 contending that, the accused has deposited the cheque amount and therefore, complainant does not want to proceed with the case. I have confronted the complainant about the contents of pursis and found the same to be voluntary. The offence is compoundable. As complainant doesn't want to proceed, permission can be granted to him as per section 257 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. Hence, the following order -

ORDER

- 1] Complaint is disposed off as withdrawn vide pursis filed by complainant at Exh.4.
- 2] The accused is acquitted of the offence punishable U/s. 5 of Payment and Settlement Systems Act, 2007 vide Section 320(8) of CrPC.
- 3] Bail bonds of accused stands cancelled, if any.
- 4] Court fee be refunded as per rules.
