Today is fixed for hearing of this Criminal Misc. Case under Section 482 of the BNSS filed on behalf of the accused persons/petitioners, namely, **Abhijit Ghosh @ Abhijit Kr. Ghosh and Rita Ghosh** who are apprehending arrest in connection with GR Case No1109 of 2026 arising out of Hasnabad PS Case No.141 of 2026, dated 06.03.2026 under 329(3)/115(2)/117(2)/109/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

Ld. P.P and Ld. Advocate for accused/petitioners are present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioners by swearing affidavit stated that no such application under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 is either filed or pending before any higher forum or rejected by any higher forum. It is also submitted that no anticipatory bail application of these accused has been rejected on earlier occasion by this Court.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused persons/petitioners submitted that the accused persons/petitioners are totally innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is also submitted that there is only allegation that the present accused/petitioner had assaulted the victim with fists and blows and there is no other allegation against them. It is also submitted that there is allegation regarding throwing of bricks towards the victim, but such allegation has been made against other accused persons of this case and not against these two accused persons. Accordingly, he prays for anticipatory bail for these two accused persons. It is further submitted that the accused persons/ petitioners are permanent residents within the jurisdiction of this Court and will not abscond if released on bail.

Ld. P.P produces case diary and raises strong objection. He draws the attention of this Court to the injury report and accordingly, he prays for rejection of the anticipatory bail prayer.

This Court has perused the materials on the case record and the case diary along with the bail application and considered the same in the light of the materials on record and submissions made by Ld. Counsels for both the sides.

On perusal of the case record and case diary, especially the statements of witnesses recorded under Section 180 of B.N.S.S and injury report of the victim, it appears that there is allegation against these accused persons of only causing hurt to the victim by fists and blows.

Considering the role played by the accused persons in the alleged offence, this Court is inclined to release them on anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the accused persons/petitioners namely **Abhijit Ghosh @ Abhijit Kr. Ghosh and Rita Ghosh** shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 3,000/- each with two registered sureties of like amount, subject to the condition that they will co-operate in the process of investigation and shall not intimidate any witness of this case or tamper any evidence of this case.

In view of the above, the application for anticipatory bail is thus disposed of on contest.
