Order No. 03 dated 05.06.2026

1. In this criminal Misc. case under section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 the accused/petitioner namely, **Chattu Das @ Rick** in connection with G.R no. of 1226 of 2026 arising out of Eco Park Police Station case No.110 of 2026 dated 17.04.2026 under section 108/115(2)/316(2) of B.N.S has come up with a prayer for grant of bail.

2. At the very outset, Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that no application for bail has either been rejected by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta or is pending for disposal before the Hon'ble Court.

3. Ld. Advocate draws my attention to the paragraph no.5 of the application under section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

4. Ld. Public prosecutor submits that there is no indication in the case diary which goes to suggest that prayer for bail for the accused/petitioner has either been rejected by the Hon'ble High Court or is pending before the Hon'ble Court for disposal.

5. The learned Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that the accused person is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that there was love affairs between the deceased and the accused and he is no way involved in this case. He further submits that he has been detained in custody since 14.05.2026. So he prays for mercy of this Court.

6. Ld. Public Prosecutor in charge opposes the prayer for bail.

7. Ld. Advocate representing the defacto complainant opposes the prayer for bail on the ground that the accused is solely responsible for the death of the deceased.

8. I have carefully perused the F.I.R. and the materials appearing in the case record particularly the statements of the witnesses recorded under sections 180 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita.

9. Considering the materials appearing in the case diary and the role of the accused in the alleged offence, I do not find any just cause to liberate the accused person on bail merely on the ground that the accused person is in custody since 14.05.2026.

10. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the accused/petitioner **Chattu Das @ Rick** stands rejected.

11. Case diary be returned at once.

12. Let a copy of this order along with the TCR be sent down to the Court concerned.

13. Misc. case is disposed of.

14. Let a copy of the order be also sent to the I.O through Ld. Public Prosecutor for information.
