This petition coming before me for hearing, on this day, in the presence of Thiru. P. Savarimuthu, Public Prosecutor for the State and of advocate Thiru. A. Manivanna Bharathi, for the petitioner and after hearing both sides and considering these necessary materials, this court today passed the following:-

ORDER

It is an application for bail filed u/s.483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

FIR was registered against the petitioner and other accused for the offences u/s. 296(b), 126(2), 118(1) and 109(1) of BNS, 2023 and subsequently, the sections were altered as u/s.109(1), 118(1), 126(2), 190, 191(3), 296(b) of BNS. The occurrence happened on 23.04.2026. As per reply given by the respondent police, the petitioner is arrayed as A3 in this case. The petitioner has been in judicial custody from 24.04.2026 onwards.

According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is an innocent and he has not committed any such offence and no previous case is pending against the petitioner and hence praying to enlarge the petitioner in the above petition on bail.

On the other hand, the learned Public Prosecutor contended that it is a case of attempt to murder and the injured was discharged from the hospital and no previous case is pending against the petitioner and the investigation is pending and objected to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Both side heard. Records perused. On perusal of records, it would show that the defacto complainant is doing a business of selling milk to society. The van driver of the

milk society who is the 1st accused was having friendship with his relative namely one Saranya and the same was warned by the defacto complainant and due to the said enmity, when the defacto complainant lifted the milkcane, the accused 1 to 3 came there and pulled down him and the accused 1 to 3 and some other accused attacked him with wooden log and stones and another unknown accused attacked him with wooden log and after that, the defacto complainant fainted and the injured was discharged from the hospital and no previous case is pending against the petitioner and the investigation is at preliminary stage. The occurrence happened on 23.04.2026. Considering the overt act against the petitioner and the way in which the offence was committed and the investigation is at preliminary stage, this court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Hence, this application for bail is dismissed.
