Today is fixed for production, and hearing of the bail applications filed by accused person namely Suman Sk.

Both the accused persons namely Suman Sk and Juhab Sk are produced from JC physically and remanded to JC till the next date.

Ld. Special PP is also present.

The bail petitions are taken up for hearing.

Perused the bail applications and considered the same in the light of the materials on record and the submissions made by Ld. Advocate for both the sides.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person namely Suman Sk submitted that the accused person is totally innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is submitted that there is no involvement of the accused person in the alleged offence and the written information is totally silent about the role played by the accused person in the alleged offence. The Ld. Advocate for the said accused person submitted that the prosecution has made a vague allegation that the accused person has some nexus with some anti-social elements in enemy country and he has caused severe threat to the security of the nation in concerned but there is no direct assertion as to what role was played by the accused person in causing such threat. It is submitted that the accused person had only handed over his mobile phone to the co-accused and apart from the same he has no knowledge about the entire matter. Emp hazing on the young age, lack of experience in life and the period of detention of the accused person in custody, the Ld. Counsel for the accused person has prayed for release of the accused person on bail on any condition,

Strong objection is taken by Ld. Special PP who submitted that the accused person is involved with a racket of anti-social elements who help the miscreants in enemy country by giving access to them to the security date of this country by providing them access through their mobile phones and helping such persons to personify themselves as Indian citizens. It is submitted that the accused person has provided OTP received on

his mobile phone to such miscreants in enemy country and thereby helping them to access such mobile phone and use the same to hack data from the various departments of the government of India and particularly the defense department and as the process of further investigation is still going on as such the release of the accused person on bail at this stage will hamper the process of such investigation. It is also submitted that the accused person had received money for his service through crypto currency mode which clearly indicates his conscious participation in the alleged offence.

On perusal of the materials in the case record and the case diary and considering the submissions of both the sides, this Court is of the considered opinion that there is sufficient materials in the case diary which gives a prima facie indication regarding the involvement of the accused person in the alleged offence. The alleged offence is very grave and the same has a direct nexus with the security of the country at large. Considering the nature and gravity of the offence, this Court finds that the present case is not fit case where the accused person should be released on bail and the prayer for bail stands **rejected**.

A prayer is made from STF for direction upon the Director-in-charge, Cyber Forensic and Digital Examiner's Laboratory to expedite the forensic examination of the mobile phone seized in connection with this case.

The prayer is allowed and Director-in-charge, Cyber Forensic and Digital Examiner's Laboratory is requested to expedite the forensic examination of the mobile phone seized in connection with this case and submit its report along with the seized article at the earliest.

Let a copy of this order be handed over to the Ld. Special PP for informing the concerned IO of this case for taking necessary action.
