ORDER BELOW EXH. NO. 4 IN A.B.A. NO. 1483/2022

The main application is filed for anticipatory bail in CR No. 84/2021 registered at Vasai Police Station for the offence punishable under section 406, 34 IPC and Sec. 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. The present application is filed for interim anticipatory bail.

2. The State is yet to appear in this application. Notice is issued to the State.
3. The argument on behalf of the applicants that, if in the meantime the applicant is arrested then the present application may become infructuous, can be considered positively.
4. It is made clear that at present the relief of interim anticipatory bail shall be granted to the applicant-accused without going into detail merit of the bail application. The fate of the main application shall be subject to the arguments by the Ld Advocate for the applicant and the Ld APP at the time of final hearing on this bail application.

Resultantly I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The application Exh. 4 is allowed to the extent of granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the applicants in C.R. No. 84/2021 registered at Vasai Police Station for the offence punishable under section 406, 34 IPC and Sec. 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.
2. In the event of arrest/surrendering, the applicants be released on bail on executing PR Bond of ₹15,000/- each and furnishing one solvent surety each, in the like amount.
3. The applicants shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any witnesses or any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer or they shall not tamper with evidence.
4. The applicants shall surrender passports, if any, to the concerned Police Station.
5. The applicants shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
6. This interim anticipatory bail order shall remain in force only till the next date.
7. The APP is required to submit on the next date the grounds of objections, if any, to the main application.
8. Inform the APP/the concerned police station accordingly.
