Order no. 13 dated 05.03.2026:

The instant application u/s. 483 B.N.S.S filed by the petitioner, **Bazlur Rahaman** in c/w Eco Park P.S. case No.215/2020 dated 18.11.2020 u/s. 304/420/468/417 of I.P.C is taken up for hearing and order.

L.C.R received. C.D is not produced.

Heard the learned advocate for the petitioner accused and the learned P.P In-charge.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been detained in custody since 17.08.2020 i.e for a considerable period of time and that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and allegations are completely false and that chargesheet has been submitted after completion of investigation and that he has permanent hearth and home and he will not abscond. In view of that, there is no need for custodial interrogation of the petitioners at this stage and considering the same, in any stringent terms and conditions, their prayer for anticipatory bail may be granted.

It is submitted by Ld. Advocate for the accused that no bail petition is pending before or rejected earlier by this court or by any upper court.

Ld. P.P in charge raises objection.

Hd. Both sides. Perused the materials in the case record. Considered.

Though the chargesheet has been submitted, but on perusal of the same, it is revealed that serious allegation was prima-facie found against the accused who was playing with the life of human beings as a fake doctor.

The applicant is the sole accused against whom the chargesheet has been submitted. So, the case is ready for trial. At this stage, I find no cogent ground to release the accused on bail. Hence, his bail prayer is rejected.

Return the L.C.R along with a copy of this order to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

The instant C.M.C is disposed of.
