ORDER

This is a petition filed by the accused to relax the condition imposed in Cr.M.P. No.1393/2026 dated 09.04.2026.

No.1393/2026 dated 09.04.2026, the petitioner was granted bail, with a condition that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station, daily at 10.00 A.M., until further orders. Hence, the condition imposed to appear and sign before the respondent police is modified to the extent that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent Police Station once in a week on every Monday at 10.00 A.M., until further orders.
