

**Order dated 05.03.2026**

Today is fixed for further evidence.

No witness for the prosecution turns in spite of serving process.

The accused person is present by taking step and filed petition to close the evidence of the prosecution as this is an old case of more than 20 years and the prosecution has failed to adduce all evidence on their part.

The prayer of the ld. adv. For the accused is allowed as per provisions of section 245(3) of C.P.C. and the record is taken up for examination of the accused person s per provision of section 313 of Cr.P.C. and during examination the accused preferred not to adduce any defense witness.

The argument is heard in full from both sides.

Now the record is taken up for passing judgment and it is prepared on three pages. The operative portion of the judgment is read over in open Court in presence of all. It is as follows :-

***“that the accused person namely Ganesh Prasad Rajbhar is found not guilty of committing any offence punishable under section 379 of Indian Penal Code. The accused person is acquitted from this case as per provisions of section 248(1) of Criminal Procedure Code and the accused person is released from his bail bond at once,***

***Any alamat seized in connection of this case be disposed off as per the provision of law after endorsing the name of the receiver of the alamat.”***
