This is an application received from Bail and Filing Section, RACC, New Delhi, filed on behalf of accused/applicant Y. Nagarjuna Rao intimating about his arrival and seeking release of fixed deposit.

Vide order dated 07.05.2024, the accused/applicant Y. Nagarjuna Rao was granted permission to travel abroad from 16.06.2024 to 22.08.2024 subject to the condition that he shall furnish personal and surety bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- lakhs and shall report back to the court within 48 hours (inadvertently written as years) after his return.

In compliance of order passed by this court dated 07.05.2024, the accused/applicant Y. Nagarjuna Rao, by way of the present application seeks to inform about his arrival in India. Perusal of the file shows that accused has returned to India on 17.08.2024. Ld. counsel for the applicant submits that accused had returned on 17.08.2024 at 9.00 pm. 18.08.2024 and 19.08.2024 being public holidays, efforts were made to file the application on 20.08.2024 but it could be filed on 21.08.2024.

Ld. counsel further submits that accused had given intimation on his arrival in India on 19.08.2024.

Considering the submissions, the delay in informing the court is condoned. Original FDR bearing no. 42953273187 drawn on State Bank of India, Hyderabad for Rs. 25,00,000/- be released to the accused/applicant or Advocate, Ms. Ariana Ahluwalia, who has been authorized by accused/applicant to collect the said FDR, as per rules against due receipt acknowledgement.

Accordingly, application stands disposed of.
